Starting at the Reading Rooms in Great Brington NN7 4JA.

Parking will be in Kimbles Field, Back Lane, Great Brington NN7 4EG.

Sunday 2th June 2024 – 10.30am

REGULATIONS:

Open to any persons, whether club member or not, entering a Veteran, (pre1915) Vintage (pre1931) or Post Vintage (pre 1940 structurally unmodified) motorcycle, sidecar, tricycle or three-wheeler of any make.

Machines must comply with all legal requirements. The event will consist of a Road Safety Rally and there will be a route of approx. We have two routes long 76miles and a shorter route of 56 Miles approximately with a lunch stop at the Countryman pub Staverton NN11 6JH The event will be held under these regulations and any final instructions which may be issued. **Please Note No petrol stations on route**

INSTRUCTIONS:

Entrants are required to assemble as directed by 10.00am and proceed immediately to the signing on point whereupon they will be supplied with the following.

- An entrant's number which must be attached prominently on the front of their machine
- A route
- A lunch voucher where appropriate

The first entrant will leave at 10.30am

GENERAL:

This year we start again from Great Brington, Northamptonshire. The run begins and ends at the Reading Rooms in Great Brington. Trailer parking is available in Kimble's field.

ARRIVAL: From 9am Onwards

Great Brington is Situated 8 miles North West from the Centre of Northampton. Great Brington is easily accessible from the M1 and A5 From the North take Junction 18 at Crick and follow the A428. From the South Great Brington is 4 miles North of junction 15 on the M1 following the A45 to Daventry and taking a right turn to The Bringtons.

CAR & TRAILER PARKING:

Parking is in Kimble Fields (Playing Field) on the left as you go up Back Lane. Look out for Sunbeam MCC Sign. See Map. If the weather is wet, plan your access and parking position carefully to avoid getting stuck on slippery or soft ground! Be considerate, bearing in mind all other Rally Entrants needing to park, and please do not obstruct access. Once unloaded ride your machine to The Reading Rooms to Sign-On, by the Village Green, Good Parking here for Bikes only. (See Map). Cost of parking and Reading Rooms is included in the fees.

SIGNING ON:

Riders and passengers to be signed on by 10.00am and it must be remembered that it is a condition of starting that you and your machine are fit to ride on public roads under UK law. Your **Route Sheets** and **Numbers and Lunch Voucher** (If pre-booked) will be supplied once you sign on. Please bring methods to fix the numbers to the front of your bike.

THE RUN:

Please have your machines ready for 10.30am for a <u>prompt start</u>.

Pre 1920's bikes will be asked to leave first in groups of two. Following this, the rest will asked to move off in numerical order as the starter indicates.

Please ride with consideration to other road users and your fellow riders.

ROUTE:

This years we have a new route which passes through picturesque rural parts of Northamptonshire / Warwickshire the morning run is approximately 35 miles while the afternoon is around 42miles we also have the option to cut short the afternoon route which would cut the afternoon route to 22miles. There is no Fuel available this year if you require fuel, please bring it to the start and we will transport it to the lunch stop please have it clearly marked.

LUNCHES:

Lunch is at the Countryman at Staverton N11 6JH, tickets are to be handed in when collecting your food. Meals have been arranged for those who ordered them on the entry forms. Please note only Ham ploughman's lunches this year. If bringing your own lunch out of courtesy please consume outside in the car park area and not in the pub.

SIGN OFF:

On completing the run, please return your machine to the allocated parking area and both riders and passengers must sign off at the desk and collect their finishers badges.

BREAKDOWNS:

FINALLY:

Lunch tickets are NOT included with this form, please remember to pick them up on the day.
